37. Ask a local business if you can put up a flyer or leave business cards by their register


38. See what's happening at your local library or rec center & show up for a community gathering

89. Take new headshots or promo photos you love
90. Create a Discord or Slack server for your community
91. Launch a course on a searchable platform like Teachable
92. Host a game night or online trivia
93. Create a useful tool or template using a service like Notion or Airtable and send it to everyone you think might appreciate it
94. Chalk the sidewalk
95. Commission a mural
96. Write a guest post for a friend or colleague's blog
97. Film a commercial (for tv or just for your website)
98. Make a giant sign & hire a sign-spinner (or do it yourself!)
99. Reach out to one new person a day for a whole month
100. Reconnect with one person you already know each day for a whole month
